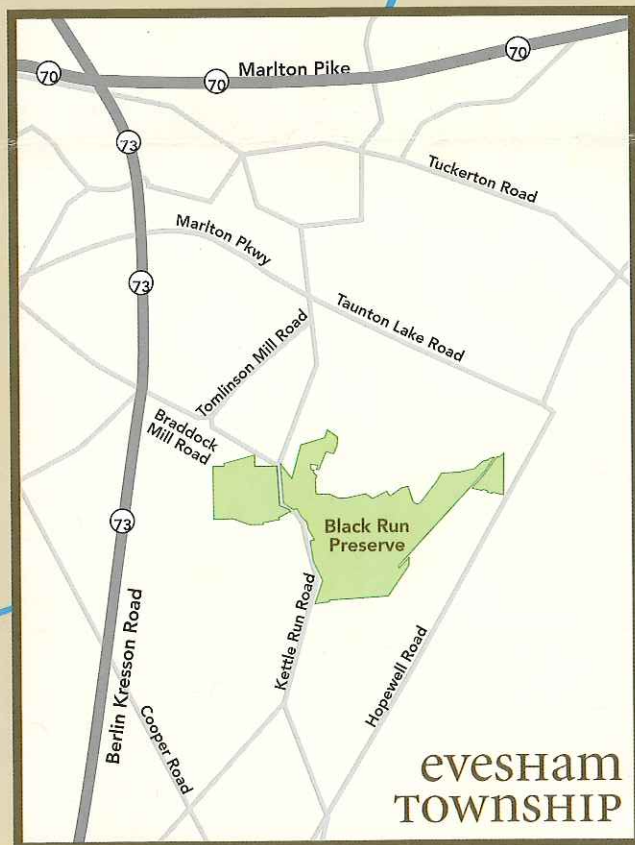
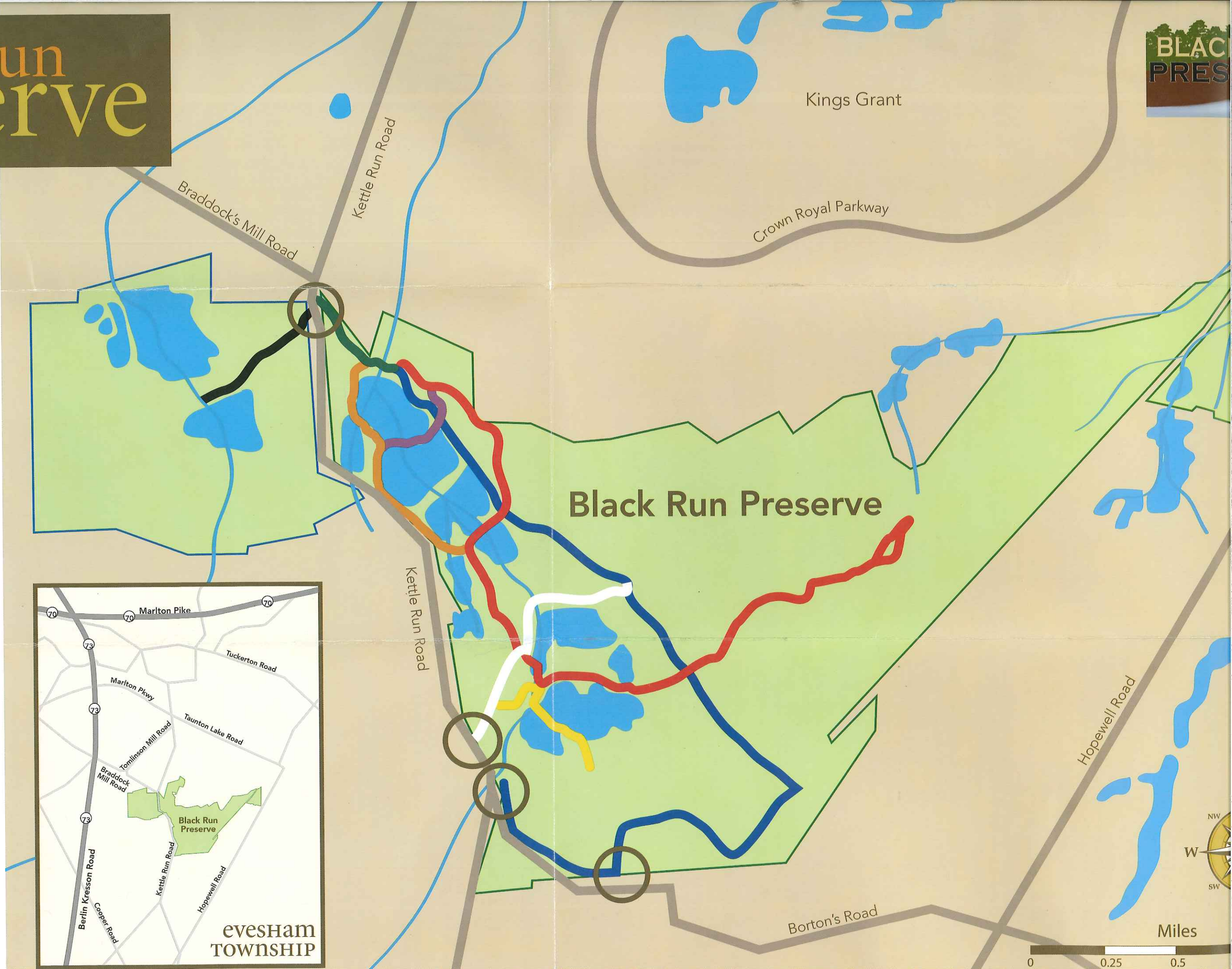
Members of the public use the Preserve at their own risk.

**PARKING:** There is currently no dedicated parking area for the Preserve. Cars can be parked beside the entrance roads or on the road shoulder near entrance points shown on the map. Please exercise extreme caution when using road shoulders along Kettle Run Road and other roads in the area. Cars often drive fast along these roads, and drivers may not expect people to be present on road shoulders or crossing these roads.

This map portrays information available at the time the map was created, but the marking and condition of trails and roads, the course of streams, and other features of the Black Run Preserve may change over time. In addition, there are risks of injury, changing weather conditions, insect bites, cars and trucks, and other risk factors in activities that are inherent in visiting and using the Preserve.
